



# **Opportunities for Prayer during the Great Fast**

If you look at the weekly schedule inside the bulletin you'll see that there are one or more services at St. Athanasius being provided each day. Before going to work you can attend the Liturgy of the 1<sup>st</sup> Hour. Typically the 1<sup>st</sup> Hour would be celebrated at 6 AM. We feel that 6:30 is more convenient so that more people can attend this less than 30 minute service. Start your work day worshipping God at our parish.

At noon Monday to Friday we're celebrating the Midday Office (also called Terce-Sext). This is a combination of the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Hours service that lasts approximately 40 minutes. Spend your lunch hour praising God in union with many people across the world that are praying at this same time.

On Wednesday and Friday were celebrating the Liturgy of Presanctified Gifts. This is a combination of Vespers with additional Lenten prayers and Communion. We're privileged to be the only Eastern Catholic church within 100 miles or more that has this ancient service. It used to be more widely celebrated throughout the entire church when it was first documented by Gregory Dialogos in the 6<sup>th</sup> century.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> All Souls Saturday is February 27<sup>th</sup> at 9 a.m. Please attend and pay homage to God for his mercy on the deceased loved ones in your family.
