Holupki (stuffed cabbage roll) with or without meat (6 oz)

Kolbasa with sauerkraut (3 oz sausage, 8 oz sauerkraut)

Halushki with cabbage (egg noodles with cabbage, onions, butter), 12 oz

Halushki with cheese (noodles, cheese, sugar), 12 oz

Pierogi (mashed potato and cheddar cheese); 3 pierogi, sauteed onions, chives, sour cream

Hot dog grilled and served with bun and choices of condiment toppings

Grilled cheese sandwich - colby jack cheese melted in between bread slices

Cabbage Slaw with poppyseed avocado mayonnaise dressing, 12 oz

Ukrainian Beet Salad (beets, potatoes, peas, carrots, dill, garlic, onion, pickles), 12 oz

Kolachy* - pastry with a variety of fillings (walnut*, apricot*, poppyseed*, lekvar*, raspberry, cherry or lemon), 4 individual kolachy

Pumpkin roll* - made with pureed pumpkin from the fall harvest, sizeable slice
