


# Galatians 2: 16-20 & Heb 13:7-16

16 YET WE KNOW THAT A MAN IS JUSTIFIED NOT BY THE WORKS OF THE LAW BUT THROUGH FAITH IN JESUS CHRIST. SO WE TOO CAME TO BELIEVE IN CHRIST JESUS SO THAT WE MIGHT BE JUSTIFIED BY FAITH IN HIM AND NOT BY THE WORKS OF THE LAW, FOR NO ONE WILL BE JUSTIFIED BY THE WORKS OF THE LAW.

17 BUT IF, IN SEEKING TO BE JUSTIFIED IN CHRIST, WE OURSELVES ARE FOUND TO BE SINNERS, IS CHRIST THEN A SERVANT OF SIN? BY NO MEANS! 18 HOWEVER, IF I AM NOW REBUILDING WHAT I PREVIOUSLY TORE DOWN, THEN I PROVE MYSELF TO BE A TRANSGRESSOR. 19 FOR THROUGH THE LAW I DIED TO THE LAW[A] SO THAT I MIGHT LIVE TO GOD.

I HAVE BEEN CRUCIFIED WITH CHRIST. 20 AND NOW IT IS NO LONGER I WHO LIVE, BUT IT IS CHRIST WHO LIVES IN ME. THE LIFE I LIVE NOW IN THE FLESH I LIVE BY FAITH IN THE SON OF GOD WHO LOVED ME AND GAVE HIMSELF UP FOR ME.

7 Remember your leaders who spoke the word of God to you. Keep in mind the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith. 8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

9 Do not be led astray by all kinds of strange doctrines. It is good for us to have our hearts strengthened by grace, and not by ceremonial foods, which have not benefited those who partake of them.

10 We have an altar[b] from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat. 11 For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest as a sin offering are burned outside the camp.[c] 12 Therefore, Jesus also suffered outside the city gate in order to sanctify the people by his own blood.[d]

13 Let us then go to him outside the camp[e] and bear the abuse he endured. 14 For here we have no lasting city, but we are seeking the one that is to come. 15 Through him let us continually offer up to God a sacrifice of praise, [f] that is, the fruit of lips that confess his name.

16 [g]Do not neglect to do good works and to share with others what you have, for these are the kind of sacrifices that please God.
