Sunday after Christmas

Galatians 1:11-19

Brethren: I would have you know that the gospel which was preached by me is not man's gospel. For I did not receive it from man, nor was I taught it, but it came through a revelation of Jesus Christ. For you have heard of my former life in Judaism, how I persecuted the Church of God violently and tried to destroy it and I advanced in Judaism beyond many of my own age among my people, so extremely zealous was I for the traditions of my fathers. But when he who had set me apart before I was born, and had called me through his grace, was pleased to reveal his Son to me, in order that I might preach him among the Gentiles I did not confer with flesh and blood, nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me, but I went away into Arabia; and again I returned to Damascus. Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to visit Cephas, and remained with him fifteen days. But I saw none of the other apostles except James the Lord's brother.

Matthew 2: 13-23

¹³ The Flight into Egypt. After the wise men had left, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and instructed him, "Arise, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt. Remain there until I tell you. Herod seeks the child to kill him." **¹⁴** Therefore, he got up, took the child and his mother, and departed that night for Egypt, **¹⁵** where they remained until

the death of Herod. This was to fulfill what the Lord had spoken through the prophet: "Out of Egypt I called my son." [a]

16 The Slaughter of the Innocents at Bethlehem. When Herod realized that the wise men had deceived him, he flew into a rage and issued an order to kill all the boys in Bethlehem and the surrounding area who were two years old or less, in accordance with the information that he had obtained from the wise men. ¹⁷ [b] Thus were fulfilled the words that had been spoken through the prophet Jeremiah:

¹⁸ "A voice was heard in Ramah, lamenting and sobbing bitterly: Rachel weeping for her children, and refusing to be consoled, because they were no more."

19 The Return to the Land of Israel. ^[c] After the death of Herod, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt ²⁰ and said, "Arise, take the child and his mother, and go to the land of Israel, for those who sought to kill the child are dead." ^[d] ²¹ He got up, took the child and his mother, and returned to the land of Israel.

²² But when Joseph learned that Archelaus^[e] had succeeded his father Herod in Judea, he was afraid to go there. After he had been warned in a dream concerning this, he withdrew to the region of Galilee. ²³ He settled in a town called Nazareth,^[f] so that what had been spoken through the Prophets might be fulfilled: "He shall be called a Nazorean."
